

Cowgirl Bootcamp Schedule

Thursday

-Guests are welcome any time after 12 pm. You will need to check in when you arrive. Stalls will be setup with shavings supplied. Hay and grain are not provided.

-Trailer parking area will be available and you can drive your vehicle up to The Hideaway to unload your personal belongings.

-You will be on your own for the evening. We can escort your group to a local pub for supper and a chance to get to know each other or...The Hideaway has a kitchen with dishes and micro. and coffee pot. We are in the heart of Amish country. Feel free to check out the area.

Friday

6:30am To the barn to feed your horses and clean stall.

7am Breakfast at The Main House

7:30am Saddle horses and be ready to head out to pasture by 8:00.

8am-12pm Its calving time. Babies, babies, babies! You will ride herd with Roger help tag, rope calves, doctor and learn how to work with your partners in safely handling cows in the pasture with a calf by her side. You might assist with pulling a calf and/or learn some of the techniques to keep an unhappy mama out of your pocket.

Noon-1:30 Head back to the barn to change or unsaddle horses and eat lunch

2 pm -5pm Depending on your group this time is reserved for rope handling and dummy roping , flight zones of cattle, sorting, cutting.etc. If your group would rather we can arrange to go amish crafts shopping.

5pm Back to the barn to do evening chores

6pm Cookout at The Main House or at The Saloon

Saturday

6:30am To the barn to feed your horses and clean stall.

7am Breakfast at The Main House

7:30am Saddle horses and be ready to head out to pasture by 8:00

8am-12pm It's time to ride out with Roger and check on the cows and calves.

Noon-1:30 Lunch !
1:30-4 pm Guided tour on horseback by Jeff “DOC” Menn, ranch owner.
4:00pm **Steak Cookout on the Ridge**
6:15pm Ride back to the barn and do chores
7 pm **Evening activities (TBA)**

Sunday

7am Feed and Clean Stalls
7:30 am Breakfast at The Main House
8 am-11am Ride herds
11 am- 1pm Lunch, Q & A, and clean up and check out.

As with any working ranch times are just a guideline and the animals will determine some of the schedule. We hope you come and enjoy an experience not everyone gets to do and see. **ALL ACTIVITIES ARE OPTIONAL.** If at any time you are not comfortable doing what is being done, you can let your cowboy know you’d just like to watch for a while. This is intended to be a new and challenging experience for you and your horse but also one you can enjoy and remember for a lifetime.

ACCOMADATIONS

You will be “bunking” with 5 other women at The Hideaway Log Cabin. 5 separate sleeping quarters, 2 baths, (one has a Jacuzzi tub), full kitchen (stocked excluding food). It is located on a private drive set in the timber.

You are allowed to bring 2 horses. We provide a box stall with shavings for each horse. We also supply shovels and wheelbarrows for your use. Hay and grain are NOT provided.
